

Worship in the Wait

10 Days of Prayers and Praises by Xochitl Dixon

Invite the Holy Spirit to be your strength as you inhale the God-breathed words of Scripture, exhale prayers and praises, and move forward with courage, confidence, compassion, and clarity . . . one breath at a time.



On January 14, 2022, I woke up in the morning and realized I could not walk. Though I've been praying with my amazing Praying-Peeps and working with my wonderful doctors, I am still struggling with high level pain, increasing fatigue, and decreasing mobility. In 2019, as I wrote *Waiting for God: Trusting Daily in God's Plan and Pace*, I shared parts of my story and developed a special way to pray through my pain. I would like to invite you to join me as we rest in God's loving presence, trust His faithfulness, and worship Him one breath at a time.

Before You Begin

Please check with your doctor before you begin, especially if you have any medical issues that can be triggered by deep breathing exercises. You're not meant to struggle or hold your breath while reading the Bible verses and guided Scripture-based prayers silently. The key is to slow your breathing at a pace that is comfortable for you.

How Do Breath Prayers Work?

These short Bible verses and prayers are designed to slow down your breathing, to relax your body, and let God's truth and love wrap you in peace as you rest in His constant presence.

Choose a time and place where you feel safe enough to be still. You can breathe prayers in a busy or quiet space, inside or outside. Before you begin reading each day's entry, inhale deeply through your nose and exhale slowly through your mouth three times. Read silently, inhaling deeply and exhaling slowly at a comfortable pace for you. Repeat as often as you like.

You can even breathe prayers and praises during your daily Bible reading and study time.

Let's begin! To God be the glory, the honor, and the praise, praise!

Eternal God, thanks for reminding me that Your work lasts forever. You planned my steps before You created me in my mother's womb. You designed each twist and turn that would lead me straight to You. You equipped me for a purpose that extends beyond my personal space, requiring me to trust Your limitless power and yield to Your loving authority. Please prepare my heart and mind to surrender in every aspect of my life, as You empower me to believe You are always working all things out according to Your perfect plan and pace. I praise You, mighty Father, for Your infallible Word, Your life-transforming love, and the work Jesus did on the cross that guarantees my inheritance as Your beloved child. I love You, generous Giver of all good things. In Jesus' name, Amen.



Day 2

The LORD is trustworthy in all he promises and faithful in all he does. Psalm 145:13

Faithful Father, thanks for fueling my faith with testimonies that prove Your eternal reliability. Thanks for being constant and constantly present. Your flawless pre-ordained plans bring You glory and give me purpose. Whether I'm relying on You to show me the next step You want me to take or waiting for You to work in the life of a loved one, please keep me from making impatience an idol. Convict me when I'm hyper focused on how long You're taking. Remind me that my concept of time is small in comparison to the reality of eternity. So, when the wait feels too long, too hard, too confusing, or too inconvenient, please keep me focused on the work Jesus has already done for me and in me and through me. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 4

Wise Counselor, thanks for showing me when I need to take a big step, baby steps, or a bit of a pause in my steps. Thanks for blessing me with just the right amount of time and helping me recognize each moment as a God-given gift that I cannot recycle. When long to-do lists lead to frustration, keep me from placing unrealistic expectations on myself and others. Infuse me with joy as I value the relationships You entrust to me. Make me a good steward of the time You've entrusted to me and never let me allow busyness to control me. Be my peace as I slow down to enjoy Your presence and include You in day-to-day planning. I trust You to reveal what I should add or delete from my lists. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 6

I stand on the firm foundation of Your goodness. Thanks for establishing a dependable tally sheet of faith-building wonders in my life, in the world around me, and in the history of Your beloved people as recorded in the Bible. Fill my heart and mind with Your truth, so I can wait on You with bold faith. Instead of asking You for hope, I'm thanking You for being my everlasting hope. Instead of asking for signs as proof of Your love or power, I'm praising You for the evidence of Your trustworthiness. My hope is secured in You and You alone. In Jesus' name, Amen.



Let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith. Hebrews 12:1-2, ESV

Kind Savior, keep my eyes steadfast on You and my feet steady on the path You've prepared for me. Help me run the race You've set before me with endurance. Strengthen my resolve and keep me from straying from Your perfect plan or predetermined pace. Deepen my willingness to focus on You, instead of glancing at the constant distractions threatening to trip me up. Help me take steps to serve You by serving others selflessly. Please don't let me be weighed down or distracted by the everchanging status of the next crisis. When things don't go the way I expect or hope, please keep discouragement at bay. Shake off doubts, insecurities, or pridefulness that can threaten to confuse me and lead me astray. Help me care for people and invest in equipping and encouraging those who come after me. Fill my well with truth and draw me into heart-deep worship daily, so I can experience peace in Your perfectly planned waiting seasons. Lead me toward the next step You want me to take. Shake off any worry about the steps that may or may not be necessary going forward. Help me stand firm today and tomorrow and forever. In Jesus' name, Amen.
